

GEORGE BRETT

AWARDS & ACHIEVEMENTS

- Inducted into Baseball Hall of Fame in 1999

George Brett wrapped up a 21-year Hall of Fame career with the Royals in 1993 after establishing himself as one of the greatest to ever play the game.

He became the only Royal and just the 11th third baseman to be inducted into the Hall of Fame on July 25, 1999 after receiving 98.2% of the votes, now the 8th-highest mark of all-time. He had his No. 5 retired by the Royals on May 14, 1994.

At the conclusion of Brett's career, he was the only player in Major League history to record more than 3,000 hits, 300 home runs, 600 doubles, 100 triples and 200 stolen bases. He was the first player to win batting titles in three decades (1976, 1980, 1990) and retired as the American League career record holder for most intentional walks (229).

A 13-time All-Star, Brett is the club's all-time leader in every counting offensive category except steals.

He was the American League MVP in 1980, finished as the MVP runner up in 1976 and 1985, was a threetime Louisville Slugger Silver Slugger Award winner, a Rawlings Gold Glove Award winner in 1985 and was crowned the Royals Player of the Year eight times.

Brett hit .390 in his MVP season, the highest batting average since Ted Williams' .406 mark in 1941.

He batted .360 during the 1985 postseason and earned ALCS MVP honors after he rallied the Royals from a 3-1 deficit against Toronto, including a 2-HR effort in Game 3. Brett had 10 hits in the 1985 World Series, including a 4-hit effort in Game 7 vs. St. Louis.

He culminated his career with his 3,000th hit on Sept. 30, 1992 as part of a 4-hit game. Overall, he guided the Royals to seven postseasons and two World Series. During his 21-year career, they had 15 winning seasons, including eight years with at least 90 wins.





Brett's statue sat outside of Kauffman Stadium from 2001-08, and was moved to its current position inside the ballpark in 2009.
